Southwest Regional Development Commission Receives \$150,000 Loan from Lyon-Lincoln Electric Cooperative REED Fund

**Southwest Regional Development Commission** was recently given a helpful hand on **February 27, 2014** when **Lyon-Lincoln Electric Cooperative** issued a \$150,000 Rural Electric Economic Development, or *REED*, loan to **Southwest Regional Development Commission**.

Approximately 88 percent of REED's lending is established in communities of less than 4,000 people and 95 percent of REED-financed projects have local ownership.
